Tell us about your design process from beginning to end and what is a typical day for you?

It all starts with inspiration that later turns into sketches, and then enters the process of designing. After that, each piece undergoes a trial period before it is sent to molding and finally finishing. A typical day for me is usually managing and balancing between my work and my family.

What message are you addressing with your jewellery and where do you stand?

I try to create my designs for the contemporary woman who is strong, self confident, ambitious, stylish and yet feminine.

Who do you collaborate with creatively?

My talent, style and imagination.

What are your favourite materials to work with?

Diamonds and pearls.

Can you tell me a little bit a about your new collection? Will it be a continuation of the last one?

There is always a continuation because of popular demand, but definitely it will be combined with new designs which I am still in the process of creating right now.





Did your artistic vision change throughout the years?

Of course, it evolved throughout the years of experience. Moreover, the flares and trends of each season and the desires of the clients all have an impact on each of my collections.

What part of your job do you like the best? And Least?

I would say the best would be the finishing process of each item and the least is the negative factors and circumstances that might affect the jewellery business.
